


FROM O'FLAHERTY'S OGYGIA WHICH WAS WRITTEN IN 1684 DURING THE REIGN OF CHARLES II

2948	Mumny, Lugne, and Lagne, sons of Herimon, succeeded their father for 3 years as Kings of Ireland.
2951	Euryal, brother to the deceased (? who) reigned 10 years.
2961	Ethrial succeeds his father for 20 years.
2981	Conmal, the son of Heber Fion, the grandson of Milesius, ruled 30 years.
3011	Tigermas, grandson of Ethrial, King of Ireland 23 years.
3034	An inter-reign of 7 years.
3041	Achy Edgathach, great-great-grandson of Lugad, the son of Ith, the uncle of Milesius, reigned 4 years King of Ireland.
3045	Hermna and Sobarch, sons of Heber, grandsons of Hir, the first from Ulster and from the house of Hir, reigned jointly Kings of Ireland 40 years.
3085	Achy Faobarglas, from the house of Heber, son of King Conmal, reigned 20 years.
3105	Fiach Labrann, great grandson of King Tigermas of the line of Herimon, reigned King of Ireland 24 years.
3129	Achy Mumo, of the line of Heber, grandson of Achy Faobarglas by his son Mogfeb, reigned 21 years.
3150	Aeneas Olmucad, son of King Fiach of the Herimonian line, reigned 18 years.
3168	Enny Airgtheach, son of King Achy Mumo from Munster, was king 24 years.
3192	Rothea of the Herimonian race, grandson of Aeneas by his son Main, was king

3831	Enny Aighneach, son of Aengus Turmeach, Heremonian line, king 10 years.
3841	Crimthann Cosgrach, grandson of Fergus the Strong, Heremonian line, king 4 years.
3845	Rudric, Hirian race, king 17 years.
3862	Innatmar, Heberian race, son of Niasedamon, king 3 years.
3865	Bresal, son of King Rudric, king 9 years.
3874	Lugad Luagne, son of King Innatmar, king 15 years.
3889	Congal Clairingneach, brother of King Bresal, king 3 years.

65	Lugad Riabnderg, grandson of King Achy Fedloch, after an inter-reign of five years, was king 8 years.
74	Conquovar Abrate, grandson of Ross the Red, King of Leinster, by his son Finn, the great grandson of Crimthann, king 1 year.
75	Crimthann Nianair, son of King Lugad Riabnderg, king 16 years.
91	Carbry Caitcheann, by a deed of violent treachery in which most of the nobility of Ireland died, became king for 5 years. He was 'of the people'.
96	Feredach the Just, son of King Crimthann, king 20 years.
116	Fiach Finnoladh, son of King Feredach, king 7 years.
123	Elim Conry, descendant of Fergus Ross, king 4 years.
127	Tuathal Bonaventura, son of King Fiach, king 30 years.
157	Mal, son of Rocrad, the grandson of Fiach, king 4 years.
161	Fedlim the Law-giver, son of King Tuathal, king 10 years.

- 171 Cathir, great-great-grandson of Conquovar, king 3 years.
- 174 Conn of the Hundred Battles, son of King Fedlim, king 38 years.
- 212 Conary of the Ernean Herimonian line of Munster, the fifth lineal descendant of the first Conary, king 8 years.
- 220 Artur, the only son of King Conn, reigned monarch 30 years.
- 250 Lugad Mac Conn of the race of Lugad the son of Ith, king 3 years. His mother was Artur's sister, of the Herimonian line.
- 253 Fergus the Black-toothed, grandson of Conn of the Hundred Battles, by his daughter Maina, and himself of the Herimonian lines as the great-grandson of Ogaman descended from Fiatach, king 1 year.
- 254 Cormac, son of King Artur, king 23 years. (Cormac Mac Art).
- 277 Achy Gonnat, grandson of King Fergus, king 1 year.
- 278 Carbrey Liffecar, son of King Cormac, king 19 years.
- 297 Fiach Srabtin, son of King Carbrey, king 30 years. Constantine the Great became Roman Emperor in 306 A.D.

- 327 Colla Huas, grandson of King Carbrey by his son Achy Doimhlen, was king 4 years.
 331 Muredach Tir, son of King Fiach Srabtin, king 25 years.
- 356 Coelbad, of the line of Hir, king 1 year.
- 358 Achy Mogmedon, son of King Muredach, king 8 years.
- 366 Crimtham, line of Heber, king 13 years.
- 379 Niall Noigiallach, otherwise Niall the Great, son of Achy Mogmedon, king 26 years.
- 405 Dathy, son of Fiachre, nephew of Niall, king 23 years, killed by lightning in the Alps in 428 A.D.
- 428 Laogaire Mac Neill, king 35 years (He was son of Niall the Great).
- 463 Oilliol Molt (or Loegh) son of King Dathy, king 20 years.
- 483 Lugaid Mac Laogaire (son of King Laogaire), king 25 years. Inter-reign 5 years.
- 513 Murcherthach Mac Earca was king 21 years. Grandson of Eugenius, great-grandson of Niall the Great. His mother, Earca, was the sixth lineal descendant of Conary the Second, who was the original founder of the Dalriedini in Scotland.
- 533 Tuathal Maolgarb, son of Cormac, great-grandson of Niall the Great by his son Carbry, was king 11 years.
- 544 Diarmait Mac Fergus Cerrbheoil, great grandson of Niall the Great, by his son Conall Crimtham, king 21 years.
- 565 Domnald and Fergus, sons of Murcherthach Mac Earca, ruled jointly 1 year.
- 566 Boathan Mac Murcherthach, son of King Murcherthach, and Achy, son of King Domnald, reigned jointly 2 years.
- 568 Ainmhire, whose father Sedna and King Murcherthach were twin brothers, the sons of Conall Gulban, was the great-grandson of Niall the Great, by his son Fergus, and was king 3 years.
- 571 Boathan Mac Nineadai, first cousin of Ainmhire, king 1 year.
- 572 Aodh Mac Ainmhire, son of King Ainmhire, king 27 years.
- 599 Aodh Slaine, son of King Diarmait, and Colman Rimhe, son of the first Boathan, joint kings 6 years.
- 605 Aodh Uairiodnach, son of King Domnald, king 7 years.
- 612 Maolcobha un Cleirech (the Cleric), son of Aodh Mac Ainmhire, king 3 years.
- 615 Subhne Meann, son of Fiachna, the grandnephew of King Murcherthach by his brother Feredach, king 13 years.
- 628 Domnald the Second (Domnald Mac Aodha mic Ainmhire), king 14 years.
- 642 Kellach and Conall Caoll, sons of King Maolcobha, joint kings 12 years.
- 654 Conall Caoll, after death of Kellach, king 4 years.
- 658 Blathmac and Diarmait, sons of Aodh Slaine, joint kings 7 years, then died of the plague in 666 A.D.
- 665 Seachnasach, son of Blathmac, king 6 years.
- 671 Kensaoladh, brother of Seachnasach, king 4 years.

- 675 Fionachta Fledach, son of Donchad, and first cousin of Blathmoc and Diarmait, king 20 years.
- 695 Loingseach Mac Aongusa, grandson of Domnald the Second by his son Aengus, king 9 years.
- 704 Congal Kennmagair, son of Fergus, and first cousin to Loingseach, king 7 years.
- 711 Fergal Mac Maoladduin, grandson of King Aodh Uairiodnach, king 11 years.
- 722 Fogarthach Mac Niel mic Kernaigh Sotail, great grandson of King Diarmait (658), king 1 year plus.
- 724 Kionaoth Mac Iorgalaigh (Kineth), whose grandfather was Conang, nephew of King Diarmait by his brother Congal, was the son of Irgal, and king 3 years.
- 727 Flaithbherthach Mac Loingsigh (Flaherty son of King Loingseach), king 7 years. Then assumed the monastic habit.
- 734 Aid Ollan, son of King Fergal, king 9 years.
- 743 Domnald III (Domnall Mac Murchada), grandson of Diermot, great-grandson of Conall Guithbhinn, the fifth in lineal descent from Surone, the sixth from Colman, who was the son of Diermot I (544 A.D.), king 20 years.
- 763 Niall Frassach (of the Showers), son of King Fergal Mac Maoladduin, and brother of King Aid Ollan, after a reign of 7 years, abdicated the crown and entered into orders in the island of Iona, and in the monastery of St. Columb Cille, in Scotland ; his remains were interred there in 778 A.D.
- 770 Donchad Mac Domnaill, son of King Domnald III, king 27 years. During his reign the Danes began to infest the coasts of Ireland and Scotland, about 795.
- 797 Aodh Oirdnidhe, son of Niall Frassach, king 22 years.
- 819 Conchubhar Mac Donchada, son of King Donchad, king 14 years.
- 833 *Niall Cailne*, son of King Aodh Oirdnidhe, king 13 years. He was drowned in the river Cailne in 846 A.D. in the 55th year of his age.
- 846 Maoilefachluin Mac Maolruanaidh (Malachy), king 16 years. He was a nephew of King Conchubhar by his brother Malron.
- 863 Aodh Finnliath, son of Niall Cailne, king 16 years.
- 879 Flann Sienna, son of King Malachy, king 37 years.
- 916 Niall Glundubh, son of King Aodh Finnliath, and son-in-law of Flann Sienna, king
 3 years. His queen was Gormlathia. He was killed in an engagement with the
 Danes near Dublin Sept. 13, 919.
- 919 Donchad II (Mac Floin), son of King Flann, king 25 years.
- 944 Congal II (Congalach mac Moilmithe), whose father Moilmith was the sixth lineal descendant of Congal, uncle of King Kianaoth (724 A.D.), was king 12 years. He was slain in battle by the Danes in the year 956.
- 956 Domnald O'Neill (Domnall Ua Neill), grandson of Niall Glundubh, by his son Murchert (Murkertagh of the Leather Cloaks), king 24 years.
- 980 Malachy II (Maoilfeachluin Mac Domhnaill), grandson of Donnchad II by his son Domnald, king 23 years. At the end of that time the kingdom was ceded to BRIAN of Munster.

THE BOOK OF McKEE

- 1002 Brian Boroimhe, of the line of Heber, king 12 years. He was killed by the Danes at the Battle of Clontarf in the 88th year of his age, on Good Friday, April 23, 1014.
- 1014 Malachy II reigned a second time, for 8 years. He was known also as Malachy the Great, and was Ireland's last king without opposition.

Inter-reign of 70 years.

- 1086 Tordelvach O'Brian, grandson of Brian Boroimhe by his son Thadeus, king 22 years.
- 1108 Murchert O'Brian, son of Tordelvach O'Brian, jointly with *Domnald Maglochliun*, great-grandson of Malachy II, and sixth lineal descendant from Domnald the brother of Niall Glundubh. Murchert O'Brian died in 1118. Domnald Maglochluin died in the abbey of St. Columba after reigning 27 years (1135 A.D.).
- 1135 Tordelvach O'Conor (Toirdelbach O'Concobair), twenty-third descendant from Achy Mogmedon (King 358-366 A.D.), king 21 years. He died May 19, 1156.
- 1156 Murchert Maglochluin, grandson of Domnald Maglochluin, king 10 years. FROM HIM THE O'NEILLS DESCENDED (p. 257 Mageoghegan).
- 1166 Roderick O'Conor, son of King Tordelvach, the last of the Irish Kings. May 1, 1169, an English invasion of Ireland commenced. In 1171 another huge force under Henry II. Roderick O'Conor abdicated in 1186 and died in 1198.
